Best Practice 1: Context

Use the provided Correlations between your state standards and the Ignite! curricula to immediately begin teaching. Use the lessons in your existing scope and sequence as a road map to teach aligned content every day of the school year.

Best Practice 2: Print + Media Together

The print materials on the Curriculum CD are essential to engage students and improve critical thinking skills. It's very simple to use lesson plans and activities together with the media to create active learning and engagement.

Best Practice 3: Daily and Repeated Use

Daily and repeated use of the Ignite! curricula is critical to deepen student comprehension. Teach daily with the COW to introduce, reinforce, and review lessons. Optimal implementation of the COW is one per teacher and multiple uses during each lesson.

Best Practice 4: Engage and Challenge

Use the pause, fast forward, and rewind buttons to fully engage students and control rate of presenting content. Teach with the COW to challenge students with questions, give writing prompts, and facilitate discussions. Actively engage students by allowing them to "drive" the COW.

Best Practice 5: Enrichment

Teach with the whole-class activities during a unit or the end of a unit to tie concepts together. Each of these challenging, problem-based learning experiences offers opportunities for first-person immersive learning environments.

Best Practice 6: Assess Learning

Continually check for understanding using daily lessons, the unit challenge, and whole-class activities. Assess learning more formally with the Unit Test.
