Type Instruction: Whole Class

Learning Objective(s): Students understand the importance of the Monroe Doctrine as a cornerstone of American foreign policy, that it reflected values from George Washington's Farewell Address, and that it has influenced the actions of later presidents.

Length of Time: 10 Minutes
